

Controller's Report for October 2019 Period 7 FY 19-20

- A surplus of \$60,578 for Member Services in the month of October and a YTD surplus of \$399,077. Total Membership YTD is 11,252.
- Development showed a surplus for October totaling \$35,028. This is due to the launch of the Annual Appeal of \$15,000 and Transition Fund of \$20,000 in the month of October. The transition fund monies will cover the costs for the upgraded computers, roof consultation, mold removal, and other incidentals. The salaries were lower due to the resignation of our Development Director at the beginning of October.
- The Museum showed a surplus of \$948 and is showing YTD surplus of \$11,634. We had 807 visitors to the museum during the month of October. YTD 6,797 visitors have enjoyed our museum.
- Education held three workshops in the month of October and showed a surplus of \$2,612 for the month.
- The Net Liquidity increased to \$370,389 in the month of October due to the Convention Receivable decreasing by \$41,000, the monies received from the annual appeal, and the monies received by the transition fund.
- The rent for the house increased to \$800 a month beginning with September 1st.
- For the month of October we had an operating surplus of \$17,725 and a YTD deficit of (\$96,008).
- October donations totaled \$50,395 which includes Chapter donations of \$2,750. Endowment donations of \$2,885 were received during the month.
- Our investments dividends total \$2,420 for October bringing them to a year to date total of \$38,885.
- Investments totaled \$3,006,393.
- The NAWCC will be receiving \$98,000 from an Estate. We have signed all paperwork and submitted to the attorney's and are waiting for the release of the check.
- Robert Gary has been working hard raising monies for the computer upgrades and other incidentals for the transition fund. He has raised \$30,250 as of the middle of December.

RKL is working on the 990 and 990-T Tax Return. That will soon be completed for review by the Finance Committee and me.

I will also begin work on account reconciliations and analysis that is much needed for further cost savings for the organization.






