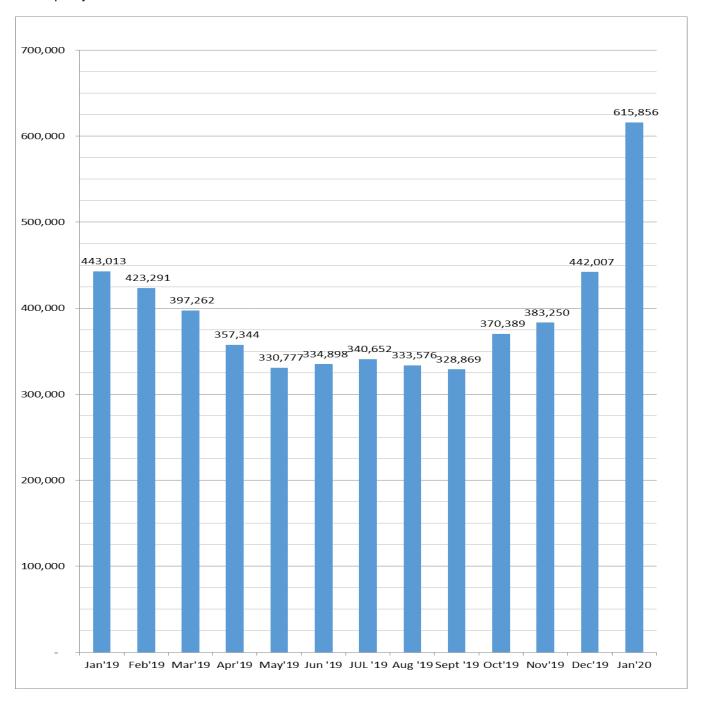
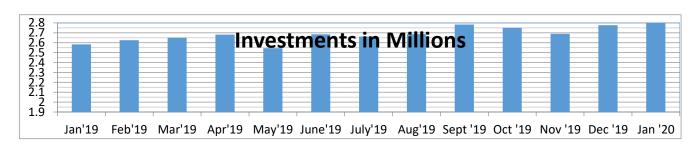
Controller's Report for January '20 Period 10 FY 19-20

Controller's Report for January '20 Period 10 FY 19-20

- A surplus of \$89,326 for Member Services in the month of January and a YTD surplus of \$634,217. Total Membership YTD is 11,141.
- The Museum showed a surplus of \$2,781 for January and is showing YTD surplus of \$13,164. Last year at this time the Museum had a deficit of (\$6,738). We had 367 visitors to the museum during the month of January (47 of those visitors came from Bus Tours). YTD 8,972 visitors have enjoyed our museum.
- Development showed a deficit for January due to the write-off of pledges that were cancelled and shows a YTD surplus of \$49,603. The transition fund monies totaling \$95K and computer fund monies totaling \$59K will cover the costs for the upgraded computers, roof repairs/consultation, mold removal, and other incidentals. So far thru January the transition fund has covered \$47,979 in incidental expenses.
- The Net Liquidity increased to \$615,856 in the month of January due to the monies received from the bequest of \$100,010 and the monies received for the transition fund.
- For the month of January we had an operating surplus of \$21,947 and an YTD deficit of (\$42,511).
- Total donations for the month totaled \$202,029 which includes a \$100k in bequest funds, Chapter donations of \$1,050 and \$10,000 from Transition Fund. Endowment donations of \$18,656 were received during the month.
- Our investments dividends total \$1,767 for January bringing them to a year to date total of \$91,182.
- Investments totaled \$3,138,559.
- Robert Gary has been working hard raising monies for the computer upgrades and other incidentals for the transition fund. He has raised \$43,000 as of the January 23rd. \$25,000 of this was matched through a special agreement with an anonymous donor.

The FY 18-19 990 and 990T tax returns have been finalized and posted to the NAWCC Website.

We still are collecting quotes on landscaping and mowing for the museum. We are also obtaining quotes for a new roof. I am also continuing to work on account reconciliations and analysis that is much needed for further cost savings for the organization.

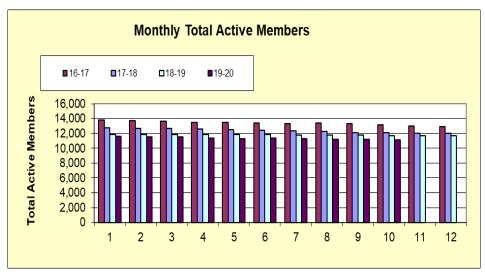

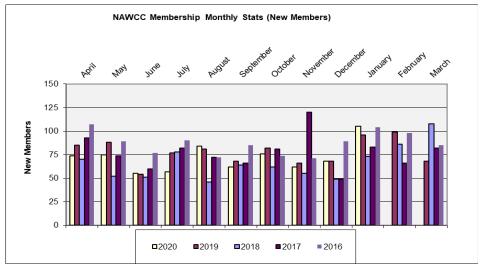

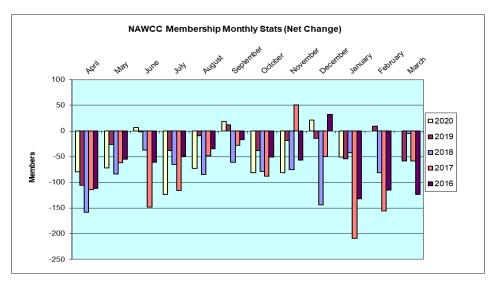
