

Thank you for contacting the NAWCC. The NAWCC is a nonprofit organization and **prohibited from** appraising items for its value. **However**, we have several services that may be helpful to you.

The NAWCC Forums is the largest community of watch and clock collectors on the internet and you can request an informal valuation or opinion (**not an appraisal**). I am quite sure you will learn a great deal about your item by posting your story with good quality pictures. You do not need to be an NAWCC member in order to post questions, but you do need to register in the Forums. It's easy. The Forums are accessible from the main NAWCC menu ([www.nawcc.org](http://www.nawcc.org)), and you can register on the Forums page. Note that the "Clocks / General Clocks Discussion" is on the top left of the Forums page and below that you will find "Watches."

Another option for research is to contact our Library & Research Center. The purpose of the Research Center is to provide information to collectors, educators and scholars using the resources available to us that includes the largest collection of publications on watches and clocks in the world. However, as already stated, we cannot appraise an item for value. Research is fee-based. A Non-Member Research Request is \$40.00 per question. If you are a Member of the NAWCC then you may ask as many questions as you wish for free. If you are not a member, a First Time/First Year digital introductory membership is a great deal. Its only \$42.00. The NAWCC also has many local chapters around the world who have buy and sell marts—there may be one in your area. Lastly, you can likely find comparable items by monitoring eBay or other auction sites on the internet to see how items are valued there.
