

J. Bryson and Mary Lou Moore Museum Service Award

This prestigious award recognizes distinguished and outstanding service to the NAWCC Museum. Candidates are selected by the NAWCC Museum Collections Committee, with final approval confirmed by the Executive Director.

After his passing in February 1999, the Museum Board of Trustees, with the endorsement of the NAWCC Council, established the award in the name of J. Bryson Moore and his wife, Mary Lou. Bryson Moore joined the NAWCC in 1964. His contributions to the Association were recognized with a Fellow Award in 1980 and a Silver Star Fellow Award in 1990. From 1988 to 1996, Bryson was a Trustee of the Museum. Mary Lou Moore donated their extensive horological library to the Library and Research Center. A plaque will be presented to the award recipient at the NAWCC National Convention Awards Banquet, the recipient's name will be inscribed on a master plaque located in NAWCC Headquarters, and the recipient will be recognized in NAWCC publication(s).

Qualifications

Candidates for this award must be members of the NAWCC in good standing, and who have performed outstanding service to the Museum.

The candidate must be nominated by an NAWCC member in good standing. The nomination package should contain a minimum of two letters of recommendation from members of the NAWCC Museum Collections Committee.

Complete and final applications for nominations for this award must be received at NAWCC Headquarters by April 30 preceding the National Convention.
