



## Appraisals

The National Association of Watch & Clock Collectors, Inc. (NAWCC) is a nonprofit, 501(c)3 organization and as such is prohibited from appraising items for their value. We do have a few suggestions that may be helpful to you.

The [NAWCC Forums](#) is the largest community of watch and clock collectors and makers on the internet. By posting a query about your timepiece in the related subject area thread, Forum members may offer an informal opinion of its value (*not* an appraisal). You will likely learn a great deal about your item from Forum members by posting what you know about your timepiece along with clear photos. You do not need to be an NAWCC member in order to post questions on the Forums, but you do need to register in the Forums: click the Register button at the top of the main Forums page.

You may wish to contact our [Library & Research Center](#) to learn more about your timepiece. NAWCC members receive research privileges at the Library and may request research services free of charge. Nonmembers may also request research assistance, with a fee being applied. Details regarding how to submit a research request and related fees are available on our [Research Requests](#) page.

Our website has a [Business Member Directory](#) that shows horological sales and service businesses in your area. One of them may be able to appraise your item or direct you to someone who can.
