The 2025 Watch and Clock Show Comes to York, PA

York, PA – Known as the largest watch and clock show in the US, the annual convention of the nonprofit National Association of Watch & Clock Collectors will be held at the York Expo Center (York, PA) on June 19-21. With nearly 500 vendors, expect to find all things horological: antique, vintage, and new watches and clocks; books; tools; parts; and more. Besides offering tantalizing opportunities to buy, sell, and trade, the show will be packed with events: lectures, mini workshops, a crafts competition, and the chance to explore the NAWCC campus in nearby Columbia, PA. The lectures and workshops are free to the public. A full schedule is available at natcon.nawcc.org.

The show kicks off with a free tailgate event open to the public on June 19 from 8:00 to 11:00 a.m. at the York Expo Center Arena parking lot. Vendors will offer a variety of vintage and antique clocks, watches, and horological tools for sale.

On June 20, a huge buy/sell/trade mart room will open to NAWCC members in the York Expo Center Arena. Hundreds of vendors will offer a variety of antique and vintage watches, clocks, tools, books, repair parts, and related objects. Those who are not part of the NAWCC may become members on-site that day and enjoy the early treasure hunting in the mart room. Plus, members can participate in the always popular live auction on the evening of June 20 at the York Expo Center Arena.

In Columbia on the evening of June 20, Bulova takes over the National Watch & Clock Museum for a free screening of its feature-length documentary *America Telling Time: 150 Years of Bulova*. Bulova historian Carl Rosen and archivist Julie Loftus will be on hand to give tours of the new Bulova exhibit.

Public Day at the show is on Saturday, June 21 at the York Expo Center Arena. Public admittance to the buy/sell/trade mart room is only \$10 at the door from 12:00 to 4:00 p.m.
