New Summer Hours at the National Watch & Clock Museum

Columbia, Lancaster County – The National Watch & Clock Museum is pleased to announce that it will be open an additional day each week throughout the summer: Sundays from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The Museum is run by the National Association of Watch & Clock Collectors (NAWCC), a nonprofit member organization dedicated to preserving and promoting the art and science of timekeeping.

"We're proud to be part of the vibrant Columbia community," NAWCC Executive Director Rory McEvoy said. "We look forward to welcoming more visitors to the museum through our expanded hours, now running from Tuesday through Sunday each week of the summer."

The National Watch & Clock Museum houses approximately 13,000 timepieces—many of which are the most culturally and historically valuable examples of their type in the world. The museum has recently updated and expanded several of its displays, including the Public Time gallery, the Hamilton and Bulova exhibits, and the history of wristwatches exhibit.
