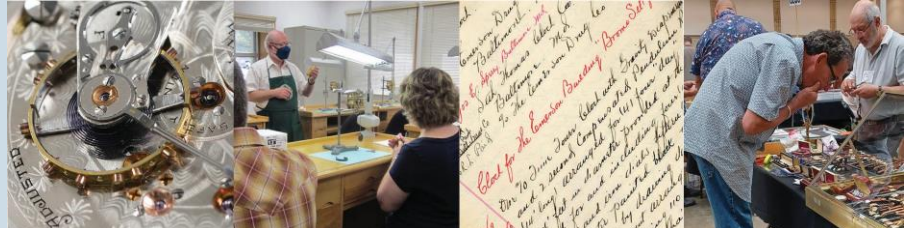

Quincy Clock Restoration

The restoration and installation of the Quincy clock at the Museum is well underway. Thanks to dedicated supporters, the Museum has already received \$8,106 in donor-designated funding.

Total costs for the project, including a new gallery space to house this wonderful treasure, are estimated at **\$135,000**. Please help us reach our goal!

Hamilton Digitization Project

At the Library & Research Center, the Hamilton Digitization Project is a critical one: time is of the essence to save archival materials stored on degrading microfilm.

This project has been awarded an Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) grant, but funding is contingent upon the Museum raising **\$39,177** in matching contributions.
